

DHRLife POLICY

Formal contract between Diaspora Home Return (DHR) NEQ 1173137325

1. DHRLife is a non-profit association whose primary aim is the provision of moral and financial support to assist with funeral cost of the remains of its members from Canada to their final resting place.
2. Partner associations commit to send 1 member to attend general assembly meetings and to respect the decisions arrived at during the general assembly.
3. The minimum membership for an association to be considered in the scheme is 10.
4. Partner associations are responsible for subscribing their members whose principal addresses are in Canada into the scheme. Membership is also open to Visitors.
5. Partner associations agree to pay a one-time \$50 registration fee to be part of the scheme.
6. Partner association agree to pay their contribution quota within the next 72 hours after receiving the notification of a death to DHR which is determined by the number of members on their role as this will enable DHRLife to accomplish its mission and honor its obligation.
7. Resident/Citizen members have a 30 days probation before they can benefit from the scheme.
8. Visitor members have no waiting period. Parents have a 3 months' probation in order to benefit from the scheme.
9. Partner associations have to provide a dead certificate of a deceased member and other documents required by DHRLife.
10. DHRLife commits to disburse \$16,000 to the family of the bereaved after ascertaining the veracity of the claim and ensuring that the deceased member was in good standing before the unfortunate event occurred.
11. Reimbursement will be done when membership reaches 1000 (one Thousand) active members.
12. Partner associations have the obligation and responsibility maintain an up to date membership information.
13. Partner associations give their consent to the publication of the list of their registered members to the DHR's website and DHR commit not to provide this information to any third party.

14. An adherent to the scheme should be registered only in one association and have only ONE matriculation number. Member associations have the responsibility to verify if their members are already registered
15. The DHRLife Scheme goes active at the registration of 1000th active members for Resident/Citizen and visitors and parents.
16. Partner Association will be provided with a copy of the bylaws and agree to be bound by its terms.
17. Changes to the terms and conditions may be done to adapt to the changing situation as need arises by the Board of Directors.

The duration of this policy is indeterminate and can be terminated at any time. The rights and obligations within this policy go into effect as from the date of account confirmation.
